OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA

- The largest employers in Oakland are in a variety of industries including health care, city and local government, and education (<u>City of Oakland Economic & Workforce Development</u>) Oakland jobs by industry sector: 20% health care, 14.5% transportation, 10.5% leisure and hospitality, 9% professional services, 8.6% education (<u>Oakland Economic Dashboard</u>).
- UPS, UCSF Benioff Children's Hospital Oakland, Southwest Airlines, and Kaiser Permanente rank among top employers in their industry sectors in the area (<u>San Francisco Business Times</u>).
- This month, Oakland's minimum wage increased from \$12.86 to \$13.23 (City of Oakland).
- Oakland's median household income (2016) is \$57,778 with an estimated 20% of individuals living in poverty (Census.gov).

NATIONAL

- 90 percent of experts agree that income volatility has increased over the last decade (<u>Aspen Institute</u>).
- At least one in four households across income, education, race, and other demographic groups have experienced substantive income shifts (Pew Charitable Trusts).
- Families facing income volatility are also significantly more likely to be evicted, miss housing and utility payments, and receive public benefits (Urban Institute).
- Nearly one in four families (24 percent) have no non-retirement savings, and more than half (52 percent) have less than \$2,000 (<u>Urban Institute</u>).
